COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- The children will learn and use new vocabulary = 1 The children will learn to retell stories and through the day in their play.
- Through role play, the children will develop their understanding of the use of social phrases.
- They will continue to participate in small group, class and one-to-one discussions, sharing their own thoughts and ideas.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- The children will continue to build their resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.
- They will enhance their skills of how to work and play cooperatively and take turns with others
- They work towards simple goals, being able to wait for what they want and control their immediate impulses when appropriate

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

MATHEMATICS

- The children will explore the composition of numbers to 9.
 - They will continue to practice automatically recalling number bonds for numbers 0-10.
 - They will explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including double facts to 10.

LITERACY

- narratives using their own words.
- They use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems and during role play
- They will continue to learn to write simple sentences.

PHONICS

- **Review sounds** sh, th, ch, qu, ng, nk
- Learn sounds ay, ee, igh , ow, oo, ar, or, air, ou, ir, ov
- Continue to read CCVC words e.g. splash, frog and CVCC words e.g. hunt, fast.
- They will practice reading real and nonsense words.
- Read red words the, he, puts, you, no, of, I said, go, to, they, my.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

- The children will explore seasonal changes focussing on Summer.
- They will talk about members of their immediate family and the community.
- They will also name and describe people who are familiar to them
- The children will continue to learn that some places are special to members of their community.
- This term, the children will learn to compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past focussing on Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.

EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

- The children will build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them
- Through music lessons, the children will continue to learn how talk about and move to different styles of music, play chime bars in rhythm to music and perform in front of others.
