As part of our Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme, pupils in **Years 5 and 6** will soon begin a unit of work focusing on **Relationships Education**. These lessons are designed to support children's understanding of themselves and others as they grow and change, and they form an important part of the statutory curriculum.

During this unit, we will cover a range of age-appropriate topics, including:

- The impact of puberty on physical and emotional wellbeing
- The importance of personal hygiene during puberty
- An introduction to human reproduction, including **pregnancy and conception**

We understand that these are sensitive topics, and we want to reassure you that the content will be delivered in a **safe, respectful, and age-appropriate** manner by experienced staff. The lessons will also be delivered to girls and boys separately. Our aim is to equip children with accurate information, develop their confidence, and help them make informed and respectful choices as they grow older.

We strongly encourage all children to take part in these lessons, as they provide essential knowledge and promote healthy attitudes. However, we also recognise that some parents may have questions or concerns.
