VE Day Celebrations 2025

On Thursday 8th May 2025, people across the country are being invited to come together to celebrate the 80th anniversary of Victory in Europe Day (VE Day). VE Day marks 80 years since the end of the Second World War in Europe. In order to commemorate this historical event, our pupils will be taking part in a wide range of activities, with their classes, to learn about the events that led up to VE Day, the celebrations that took place and the impact that this had on the United Kingdom.

As part of the celebrations on the 8th May, we are inviting all pupils to come to school wearing:

Red, white and blue party clothes which reflect the period and represent the colours of the United Kingdom.

Pupils should not wear:

- **Football/Sports Kits**
- **Dress-up costumes such as superheroes, princesses etc**

In addition to the activities that will take place throughout the day, we will also be serving a special celebration VE day lunch. A menu will be sent out closer to the time.

In the afternoon, the pupils, staff and governors will gather for a celebration assembly where the pupils will showcase their work.
