How to help at home:

Complete home learning:

- Set on Thursday on Microsoft Teams.

- Due back on Monday in home learning books

Read daily with your child

Practise sounds and word reading

using RWI phonics videos

Practise recall of number bonds to 5/10/20.

Practise spelling words, forming letters correctly and writing simple sentences.



MATHEMATICS

- The children will explore position and direction, learning about movement and where things are.
- Children will be introduced to coins and notes, developing an understanding of money and its uses.
- The children will learn to tell the time to the hour and half past. They will explore and solve simple time-related problems using concepts such as quicker, slower, earlier, and later.



COMPUTING

Maze Explorer

- The children will learn how to create and debug a set of instructions (algorithm).
- They will explore what a spreadsheet program looks like and use tools to input data into cells.



MUSIC

- The children will consolidate their learning from throughout the year by revisiting songs and musical activities.
- They will listen to and appraise classical music and use their voices to sing songs, as well as speak chants and rhymes.



RE

- The children will learn that babies are very special and that their birth is often celebrated.
- They will learn that some religions have special naming ceremonies to welcome a baby and give them their name.



ENGLISH

- Our focus story is *Peace at Last*. The children will learn to write a list of sounds and a simple innovative story. They will read a poem called *The Sound Collector* and use the ideas from the poem to create their own poem.
- Children will continue daily phonics and reading. Please support your child in accessing Oxford Owl to practise reading.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- The children will learn about different sports.
- They will master movements, including running, jumping, throwing and catching, while developing their balance. They will participate in team games in preparation for Sports Day.

PSHE and RSE

- Our Big Question this term is: *How can we tell the truth even when it feels tricky?* The children will read *What Sid Did*, which will help them understand the importance of telling the truth.
- They will talk about their transition to Year 2.



GEOGRAPHY

- The children will learn about the seven continents and five oceans.
- They will explore how continents are similar and different in terms of their human and physical features.

DT:

- The children will learn about cooking and healthy diets.
- They will practise using tools safely.
- They will design and make their own pizza.



SCIENCE

- The children will learn about the changing seasons and explore the differences between spring and summer.
- They will discover the animals that can be seen during different seasons and learn how weather affects the world around us.
- The children will develop their understanding of weather and how to stay safe in different conditions.
