How to help at home:

Complete home learning:

- Set on Thursday on Microsoft Teams.
- Due back on Monday in home learning books

Read daily with your child

Practise 2, 5 and 10 x tables

Practise spelling words, forming letters correctly and writing simple sentences.



MATHEMATICS

- The children will be learning about Mass, Capacity and Temperature as well as position and direction with a focus on using positional language such as clockwise and anticlockwise to describe movement.
- They will also be consolidating their understanding of the 4 operations (+-X÷) and use this to solve problems



COMPUTING

Making Music:

- The children will explore how to edit and combine sounds. They will use the 2Sequence software to compose a tune, add sound effects and improve it.

Questioning:

- They will also use 2Count to create pictograms and a binary tree to separate information.



MUSIC

- The children will learn the song 'I Wanna Play in a Band'. They will continue to develop their understanding of pulse, rhythm and pitch as well as how to play the glockenspiel with increasing accuracy.



RE

- The children will learn about sacred buildings and how these special places make people feel.



ENGLISH

- Children will read 'The Twits' and write an extended narrative and a character description.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Invasion Games: The children will develop skills such as attacking and defending in various ball-based games. They will also develop their physical & spatial awareness and teamworking abilities.
- Net and Wall games: children will focus on the fundamentals of sending, receiving, rallying and moving with control. They will also participate in running, jumping and throwing activities that accurately replicate events in preparation for Sports Day.
- **PE Days:** Tuesdays and Thursdays



TOPIC

- **Geography:** The children will be learning about 'UK Seasides and Coasts'. They will learn about the different physical features of the coast and identify seaside locations in the UK. They will also compare coastal landscapes with inland landscapes and identify why people visit the seaside.
- **Art:** The children will explore textiles through the work of a range of craft makers and designers. They will describe the differences and similarities between practices and then create a Camelia flower using felt.



SCIENCE:

Living Things and their Habitats / Plants:

- The children will continue their understanding of how habitats provide for living things needs.
- They will also revisit learning about plants as part of a scientific enquiry.



PSHE

- This term our theme is: *We are BRAVE*. The children will learn life skills and an awareness of local risks.
- They will also explore transition as their prepare for Year 3 in Key Stage 2.
