How to help at home:

Complete home learning:

Practise 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 x tables.

Practise spelling words and writing sentences using the correct punctuation.



MATHEMATICS

- Children will be recapping their knowledge of place value
- Children will be developing their understanding of multiplication and division, with a focus on the 3, 4, and 8-times tables.
- Children will use what they know about times tables to multiply and divide 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers.
- Children will learn about length and perimeter. We will focus on measuring using millimeters, centimeters, and meters.

MUSIC

- Children will be learning Three Little Birds by Bob Marley – a Reggae song. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Reggae songs.



RE

- Children will continue to learn about Hinduism. They will look at the puja plate and its significance.



ENGLISH

- Children will be reading The Bear and the Piano by David Lychfield. At the end of the unit, children will be able to write an innovative narrative and a non-chronological report.
- This term, children will continue to master their skills in grammar, reading comprehension and class discussions.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will be focusing on fitness and gymnastics this term. They will work on their balance and core strength.

TOPIC

- In History, children will be learning about the Stone Age. They will explore the lives of hunter-gatherers, reasons why Stonehenge was built and a region called Skara Brae.
- In Art, children will study the life and work of Vincent Van Gogh. At the end of the unit, children will create their own version of Starry Night.



SCIENCE

- Children will be learning about rocks.
- Children will learn about different types of rocks, how they are formed, the importance of fossils, and the importance of soil.
