MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn about Money. They will add and subtract money. They will also learn to find change.
- Children will learn about mass and capacity. They will compare and recognise different units for both mass and capacity.



COMPUTING

- Children will learn how to present with Microsoft PowerPoint.
- Children will create a page in a presentation adding media to their presentation. They will use animations and timings to add excitement to their final set of slides.



MUSIC

- Children will continue to learn the song 'Bringing Us Together – a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity.
- They will continue to practise playing the recorder and glockenspiels.



RE

- Children will continue to learn about Judaism.
- They will learn how Jews today show the importance of the Jewish Temple and the kingdom of Israel
- They will also learn the Samuel, Saul and David Stories.



ENGLISH

- This term, children will be reading Ottoline and the Yellow Cat by Chris Riddell. Children will continue to master their knowledge of expanded noun phrases and adverbs. Children will write a character description. In a film unit, children will explore the main character before writing a diary entry.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will learn about athletics. They will master basic, fundamental movement skills from Key Stage 1, including running, jumping, and throwing. They will practise how to move safely in a space, showing awareness of others.

TOPIC

- In DT children will explore textiles. They will learn joining methods in sewing. They will create their own applique.
- In Geography, children will learn about mountains.



SCIENCE

- This term, children will learn about Light.
- They will learn that they need light to see things, and that dark is the absence of light.
- Children will learn that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.
- Children will be able to recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.
