How to help at home:

Complete home learning:

MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn about statistics ; they will interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables
- Children will revise and develop their knowledge of time and shapes



COMPUTING

- Children will develop coding skills using 2Code.
- They will use flowcharts in 2Chart.
- Children will begin to use timers.
- They will use testing and debugging techniques to check and correct their coding.



MUSIC

- Children will continue learning the song 'Bringing Us Together - a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity.
- They will continue to practise playing the recorder and glockenspiels.



RE

- Children will continue to learn about Judaism.
- They will learn about how Jews today show the importance of the Jewish Temple and the kingdom of Israel.
- They will learn the Samuel, Saul and David Stories.



ENGLISH

- Children will be reading and exploring the story 'The Iron Man' written by Ted Hughes. They will write their own character description as well as explore letter writing and newspaper articles.
- Children will also read 'A Kid In My Class' written by Rachel Rooney. They will write their own performance poem



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will learn to take part in tag rugby
- They will develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles in tag rugby.



TOPIC

- In Food Technology, children will learn basic cutting skills. They will prepare a couscous salad
- In History, children will continue to learn about Ancient Greece, diving into the origins of democracy and philosophy.



SCIENCE

- This term children will explore types of nutrients humans need to stay healthy.
- Children will look at different types of food and classify them into their food groups.
