#### **MATHEMATICS**

- Children will learn about Money. They will add and subtract money. They will also learn to find change.
- Children will learn about statistics. They will interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables



#### COMPUTING

 Children will learn how to present with Microsoft PowerPoint. Children will create a page in a presentation adding media to their presentation. They will use animations and timings to add excitement to their final set of slides.



#### **MUSIC**

- Children will continue to learn the song 'Bringing Us Together - a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity.
- They will continue to practise playing the recorder and glockenspiels.



#### RF

- Children will continue to learn about Judaism.
- They will learn how Jews today show the importance of the Jewish Temple and the kingdom of Israel

#### **ENGLISH**

• This term, children will be reading Ottoline and the Yellow Cat by Chris Riddell. Children will continue to master their knowledge of expanded noun phrases and adverbs. Children will write a character description and a narrative. In the story, children will create their own bad character taking inspiration from some of the other villains in the series.



## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will learn how to play basketball.
- They will develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games



#### **TOPIC**

- In Art and Textiles, children will explore how animals are an inspiration for artists.
- In Geography, children will learn about Volcanoes.



#### **SCIENCE**

- This term, children will learn about Light.
- They will learn that they need light in order to see things, and that dark is the absence of light.
