How to help at home:

Complete home learning:

MATHEMATICS

- This term, children will work on their number skills, looking at place value.
- Children will also be learning about addition and subtraction.



COMPUTING

Online safety

- Children will discuss the importance of passwords and keeping passwords safe.
- Children will discuss how to use the internet safely and look at blogging.
- Children will learn to touch type.



MUSIC

- Children will learn the song Let Your Spirit Fly and practise singing and playing the glockenspiel and recorder.



RE

- Children will learn why Rama and Krishna are important in Hinduism and what their stories teach Hindus today.



ENGLISH

- Children will focus on the text Mae Among the Stars .
- They will write a story (narrative) from the point of view of Mae C. Jemison.
- They will write a fact file about space.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- The children will be learning to develop their football and fitness skills.

TOPIC

- In Art, children will learn the technique of marbling, taking inspiration from the artist Jackson Pollock.
- In History, children will be learning about the Stone Age. They will explore the lives of hunter- gatherers , reasons why Stonehenge was built and a region called Skara Brae.



SCIENCE

- This term, children will learn about animals including humans.
- They will look specifically at movement
- Children will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles, and how this helps them move.
- They will be working scientifically by conducting their own experiments
