Complete home learning:

MATHEMATICS

- This term in Maths, the children will learn about place value up to 1000.
- They will learn how to add and subtract two four-digit numbers which include exchanging.
- They will also be learning their times tables.



COMPUTING

- This term the children will learn about Online safety.
- They will learn how to search for information safely using a search engine.



RE

- This term the children will be focusing on Christianity and the family of Jesus. They will also be learning about key places in Judea BC.



ENGLISH

- This term the children will be reading The Journey by Francesca Sanna.
