MATHEMATICS

- In Maths, children will be exploring fractions and decimals further.
- They will also be comparing both fractions and decimals.
- They will be rounding decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number.
- They will also solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.



COMPUTING

- In Computing, children will be learning about Artificial Intelligence.
- The children will learn what AI is, how to use it safely and what the limitations are.
- Children will also explore audiobooks and learn how to record and add sound to an audiobook.



MUSIC

- Children will continue to develop listening and singing skills, including improvisation and performance.
- Children will learn Blackbird, a song about civil rights.
- They will continue to practise playing the recorder and glockenspiels.



RE

- The children will continue with their learning of Christianity through the messages of Jesus.
- They will learn about the importance of the Disciples' messages and their influence on the New Testament.



ENGLISH

- Children will be reading the novel, *The Spiderwick Chronicles*.
- They will use the novel to inspire their own fantasy writing with an emphasis on setting description.
- The children will also complete a non-chronological report describing their own character.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

- This term children will be focusing on Athletics
- Children will be preparing to take part in Sports Day.

GEOGRAPHY

- In Geography, children will learn about why earthquakes and volcanoes happen.
- They will learn how the size of earthquakes are measured and how people are affected during and after an earthquake.



SCIENCE

- Children will learn about the different states of matter.
- They will learn about the different properties of a gas, liquid and solid.
- The children will investigate how to change a solid into liquid and how to change a liquid into a gas.
