How Parents Can Help

Encourage your child to complete all their home learning. Please help your child to learn their weekly spelling words and times tables. Listen to your child read and comment in their reading records daily.

MATHEMATICS

- In Maths, children will be learning the days, weeks and months in a year and how to convert between them.
- They will learn to identify, describe and compare different angles.
- Children will use their knowledge of angles to describe the features of 2D and 3D shapes.
- They will compare and contrast shapes.
- Children will learn how to interpret, analyse and create different charts.



COMPUTING

- In computing, the children will be learning about animation. They will be creating their own animations using a computer programme and learn how to add movement and sound.



RE

- The children will be learning about Islam and the rituals associated with fasting during the month of Ramadan. They will learn how the breaking of a Muslim's fast each day can bring families and communities together and helps strengthen their faith.



ENGLISH

- In English, the children will be completing a visual literacy unit using the story, *The Ghost of Pere Lachaise*. They will be writing a first-person narrative and a biography of a historical figure.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- This term children will be focusing on Basketball and Dance.
- They will take part in our annual Sports Day.



TOPIC

History

- Children will be learning about the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. They will learn where the Vikings came from, why they wanted to settle in Britain and how the Anglo-Saxons defended themselves against them.

Art

- In Art, the children will be learning about the artist Piet Mondrian. They will learn about the features of abstract art and will create their own sun catchers inspired by Mondrian's art.



SCIENCE

- In Science, children will learn about sound.
- They will learn about how sound is heard through vibrations and the difference between volume and pitch.
- They will also learn and label the different parts of the outer and inner ear.



PSHE and RSE

- Children will learn about healthy, positive friendships.
- They will also learn about changes that occur in their bodies during puberty and how to manage money.



MUSIC

- Children will continue to develop listening and singing skills, including improvisation and performance.
- Children will continue to learn and perform the song, *'Blackbird.'*
- They will continue to practise playing the recorder and glockenspiels

- Children will learn how to talk about items at the café as well as how to order.
